Our objectives

Faculty of Agriculture and Economics is the oldest one at the University of Agriculture in Krakow. Its educational offer comprises full-time and part-time programmes, in compliance with the European Union standards. The Faculty is fully authorized to grant academic degrees and academic title of agricultural sciences in the field of agronomy.

Agriculture programme offered at the Faculty helps the graduates to acquire a comprehensive knowledge in the field of agriculture and agricultural technologies, including supplementary modules, like horticultural or livestock production or economic module, which improves employment opportunities at the competitive 21st century labour market.

General Information

The undergraduate programme lasts 3.5 years (7 semesters). The syllabus bases on essential and general subjects, such as: botany, chemistry, plant physiology or economics and thematic areas (modules) addressing a variety of issues, including technical, bases of agriculture, agricultural production, horticultural production, livestock production, and agricultural economics module. Each module is composed of lectures, seminars and lab classes. About one third of all courses is optional.

The program provides also an opportunity to learn Polish language and culture.

Classes and lectures start on two dates: 1 October and 15 February.

The minimum number of candidates to start the programme is 10 persons. Small groups will ensure individual working relations between students and teachers. Students' progress is evaluated on the basis of their active participation in and contribution to the programme.

After completion of this Bachelor programme, the graduate will be awarded the Professional title of inżynier (engineer) with a note that the programme was taught in English. The graduates may follow their education in postgraduate (second cycle) programme Agroecology and also in PhD programme.

Fees:

Tuition fee: depending on the programme, the tuition fee varies from 2 000 – 3 500 EUR per year.

Necessary documents:

- printout of the online application in the University system

- confirmation of admission payment
- documents confirming possessed education with apostille (more)
- certified translation of the documents to the English language done by a sworn translator
- document certifying the knowledge of English
- medical certificate stating that there are no contraindications to undertake education in a chosen field of study and form of education
- document that certifies the candidate's possession of health insurance or casualty insurance for the period of studying in Poland
- four photographs (35mm x 45 mm) taken according to the guidelines for issuing visa
- the copy of the first page of passport with personal information and photo.

MASTER'S DEGREE PROGRAM

Dear Candidates,

On June, 2018, the recruitment process for a master`s degree at the Faculty of Agriculture and Economics has started as the element of the didactic project “University of Agriculture – open space for you!”. As the part of the project, 4- semester MA studies (second cycle) are offered in the following two fields: Agriculture and Environmental protection. The language of instruction is English.

In the incoming year, we intend to continue the recruitment for the paid MA studies. The recruitment will last until the end of January 2020. The start of classes is in the summer semester (February 2020). Tuition fee for foreign students is 1,000 Euro per semester.

MA studies in the fields of Agriculture and Environmental protection give a unique opportunity to obtain a master`s degree, but also to deepen English language skills in the field of the industry.

Didactic project

“The University of Agriculture – open space for you!”

Characteristic of the fields of MA studies:

- **Environmental protection** – Studies educate in the field of preparation for the implementation of practical activities, aimed at ensuring the quality of the natural environment, including rural areas for agricultural production, resulting from the EU and other countries' regulations.
- **Agriculture** – Studies provide preparation for the work in the field of crop production, environmental protection, agricultural economics and cooperation units. After graduation, the student has knowledge of agricultural production and methods of economic analysis, organization and management, as well as knowledge enabling food production and processing.

Place of project implementation and financing: Project “The University of Agriculture – open space for you!” is implemented by the Faculty of Agriculture and Economics as part of the Operational Program Knowledge Education Development, 3rd priority axis “Higher education for economy and development” and measure 3.3. “Internationalization of Polish higher education”. The project is financed by the National Centre for Research and Development.

Objectives of the project: The main objective of the project is to improve the availability of international education programs for students of the Faculty of Agriculture and Economics at the University of Agriculture within the following two fields: **Agriculture** and **Environmental protection**. The additional value of the project is the opportunity to study in the international environment and to educate in English by highly specialized staff.

Main assumption of the project: The project consists of 4-semester second cycle (MA) studies, conducted in English on two different faculties: **Agriculture** and **Environmental protection**.

Target group: Graduates of full-time studies (Engineering and Bachelor studies). In the case of foreign students, it is necessary to present a nostrified school-leaving certificate. Students finish their studies with the defence of their master`s thesis.

Recruitment: **The recruitment pocess runs from July 1, 2019 to January 30, 2020. Classes will start in February 2020.**

Staff: The staff involved in the project is highly qualified (research and teaching), with the title of at least PhD and fluent English speaking, as well as scientific teachers from abroad.

Szanowni Państwo,

W dniu 1 czerwca 2018 r. rozpoczął się nabór na studia magisterskie na Wydziale Rolniczo-Ekonomicznym stanowiące element projektu dydaktycznego „The University of Agriculture – open space for you!”. W nadchodzącym roku akademickim 2019/2020 mamy zamiar kontynuować nabór na te kierunki, głównie dla studentów zagranicznych, ale o przyjęcie mogą się ubiegać obywatele naszego kraju. Nabór będzie trwał do końca stycznia 2020 r., a rozpoczęcie zajęć w semestrze letnim – luty 2020 roku.

Studia magisterskie **Agriculture** i **Environmental protection** dają niepowtarzalną okazję nie tylko do uzyskania tytułu magistra, ale również pogłębienia znajomości branżowego języka angielskiego.
